**Orthopedic Surgeon Bruce Greene, M.D.,  
Joins CRMC Medical Staff**

Cortland Regional Medical Center is pleased to welcome Dr. Bruce L. Greene, Orthopedic Surgeon, to its Medical Staff. Dr. Greene is a board certified orthopedic surgeon with expertise in knee arthroscopies, ACL reconstruction, shoulder arthroscopies, rotator cuff repairs, and sports medicine. Dr. Greene's new practice, *Joint Innovations*, is located in the Regional Medical Practice building, 1095 Commons Avenue in Cortland. Appointments for consultations can be made by calling 758-3750.

Dr. Greene brings over 17 years of surgical experience to the Cortland community. His particular area of interest is in total knee arthroplasty. In January 2008, Dr. Greene began using a revolutionary new "custom fit" approach to total knee replacements. The new technology, which uses custom cutting guides and computer software, provides for bone and ligament conservation and allows for improved implant fit and alignment. According to Dr. Greene, the new procedure has been shown to result in quicker and less painful recovery, increased range of motion, a more natural feeling knee, and greater ease in performing normal activities. He is one of only 400 surgeons nationwide trained in the "custom fit" approach. Dr. Greene performs this surgery at Cayuga Medical Center, Auburn Memorial Hospital, and now Cortland Regional Medical Center.

A graduate of Yale University, Dr. Greene went on to earn his medical degree at Rutgers University (Piscataway, NJ). He continued his training at University Hospital (Newark, NJ) where he completed a two-year residency in general surgery, followed by a five-year orthopedic surgery residency. Dr. Greene then completed a sports medicine fellowship at Case Western

Reserve University (Cleveland, OH).

Among his many professional affiliations, Dr. Greene presently serves as team physician for both the Cornell University men's and woman's basketball programs, and is an orthopedic consultant for the Ithaca College sports teams.
